Reporting to Birchcliff’s Asset Integrity Supervisor, the Asset Integrity Coordinator will be responsible to actively participate in the implementation and monitoring of the asset integrity program activities for pipelines, pressure equipment, piping, and related facility equipment including non-pressure above and below ground storage. The Asset Integrity Coordinator is a key technical field role in the Asset Integrity team looking after both pipeline and facility assets.

Key Responsibilities:

- Provide day-to-day support and coordination for the completion of processes and tasks as described in Birchcliff’s Pressure Equipment Integrity Management Program (PEIMP) and Pipeline Safety and Loss Management Program (SMLS).
- Provide support, as directed, for pipeline and pressure equipment inspection, and maintenance activities such as inline inspections, visual inspection, nondestructive examination, pressure safety valve maintenance, pipeline integrity confirmation digs, chemical verification, bacteria testing, pigging programs and corrosion coupon monitoring.
- Work with Operations staff to ensure that new pipelines are inspected and commissioned properly including communicating details with BIR Asset Integrity, BIR Operations and current integrity vendor.
- Assist with data gathering, data input, internal audits, and system maintenance for pipeline integrity activity in the associated databases (Asset management systems).
- Work with service providers and Operations staff to ensure corrective actions related to Asset Integrity are implemented as required including tasks stemming from Management of Change program, inspections, audit findings and non-conformances.
- Manage Replacement in Kind Work Order system.
- Coordinate third party crossings of Birchcliff pipelines, backfill and critical HDD operations.
- Assist as directed in audits (AER & ABSA, and internal) of facilities or pressure equipment.
